



Workplace Health and Safety Declaration Checklist

Work Experience Students

As a minimum, and as required by the CWS Workplace Health and Safety Department, all prospective Work Experience students should meet the following requirements.

Work Experience students must be able to:

- Work in all weather conditions (hot, humid, rain, cold conditions [raincoats and sunscreen provided by CWS]).
- Be able to spend large amounts of time on your feet (between 2-3hrs before a break).
- Walk up to 4-5kms per day.
- Run briefly in the event of an emergency.
- Confidently react and respond to instructions given in an emergency situation.
- Freely bend, twist, walk, stand, lift and carry.
- Comfortably communicate with visitors and staff.
- Take directions from Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary staff.
- Be able to prepare/cut food for animals (including preparing meat and fish products such as day old chicks, mice, mince, invertebrates and cadavers).
- Be described as being in a generally fit and active state.

If you have any concerns on the above requirements, please speak to the CWS Education department Manager before applying for this program.

Where possible, and where practicable, if a prospective Work Experience student cannot meet one/some of the above requirements, accommodation MAY be made to allow the prospective student to participate in some alternative activities at Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary. This decision is at the sole discretion of the CWS Education department Manager.
