



Go wild seven nights a week at Currumbin

The Wildnight Adventure, now offered seven nights a week, gives families the chance to enter the darkside and see the Australian bush like never before - as it comes alive with amazing nocturnal wildlife on an interactive, guided tour.

With new wildlife experiences, new tour inclusions and even more fun for families Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary's Wildnight Adventures are the wildest nightlife on the Gold Coast for all ages.

And better still, it means that families on the Gold Coast have an even wider choice of activities suitable for children and adults day and night.

On each Wildnight Adventure, guests are specially guided through the Sanctuary by wildlife officers who provide insights and the chance to get up close and personal with some of Australia's most amazing nocturnal animals.

Guests can see one of the biggest Saltwater Crocs in Australia, hand feed the big mob of friendly kangaroos and get close to the koalas.

There's also the chance to witness the Tasmanian Devil and other things that growl, hop and slither as they get stuck into their evening meals.

The guided format and special activities, including a traditional Aboriginal dance performance by members of the Nyulejam Dance Troupe, make the Wildnight Adventure a great nighttime activity for families on the Gold Coast.

Even for families who have visited Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary during the day, the Wildnight Adventure is still a great option as a totally new experience.

Comfortable walking shoes and a warm jacket are recommended for guests, to get the most out of their nocturnal wildlife experience. Wildnight Adventures operate from 7.20 pm to 9.45 pm each night, except Christmas Day and New Year's Eve.
